# Are you ready..... Senior Information

-Create and use a professional email

-Apply to 4 or more institutions, jobs, etc.

-When applying complete scholarship application

-When picking colleges consider: Academics, Location, Size, Grad Rate, Majors, Resources, and Campus life/services

-Visit the college site for any specific information for your college/major

-Create a calendar that includes deadlines for applications, essays, financial aid, etc.

-Write your essay and get them proof read before submitting

-Write a resume (include items not on your school records) and keep track of awards and accomplishments

-Ask for letters of recommendation, give the person 2 weeks or longer to write it, and provide them with a resume -Send all required documents ASAP!

-Ask questions!!
