# DUAL CREDIT INFORMATION

- Dual Credit allows BHS students to take college classes that also count for High School credits.
- BHS students can enroll in Dual Credit with Coastal Bend College or Del Mar College by meeting the schools requirements.
- Most classes require either ELA or Math TSI to be passed
- We offer TSI at BHS numerous times throughout the year
- We offer reimbursement for tuition and books for Core Area classes based on grades earned in the course.
- For reimbursements to be processed a copy of the bill/receipt and grades (for tuition) must be submitted to Ms. Davis**

- Foundation High School Program

This program is a core set of classes in the areas of Math, English, Science, Social Studies, Foreign Language, Fine Arts, Physical Education and electives that all students must complete to graduate.

- Endorsements

All incoming ninth grade students will select an Endorsement as a plan to complete the required credits for graduation.

  - .5 Communication Application credit
  - 6.5 elective credits
  - \*\*PLUS CREDIT REQUIREMENTS FOR AN ENDORSEMENT
- 5 STAAR TESTS: Eng 1, Alg 1, Bio, Eng 2, US History



# **REQUIREMENTS FOR DISTINGUISHED LEVEL OF ACHIEVEMENT**

- **26 CREDITS**

Same as Foundation plus endorsement

- 4 Math credits (must take Algebra 2)
- 4 Science credits (2 Advanced credits)
- **A STUDENT MUST EARN THE DISTINGUISHED LEVEL OF ACHIEVEMENT TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR 10% AUTOMATIC ADMISSION TO COLLEGE.**

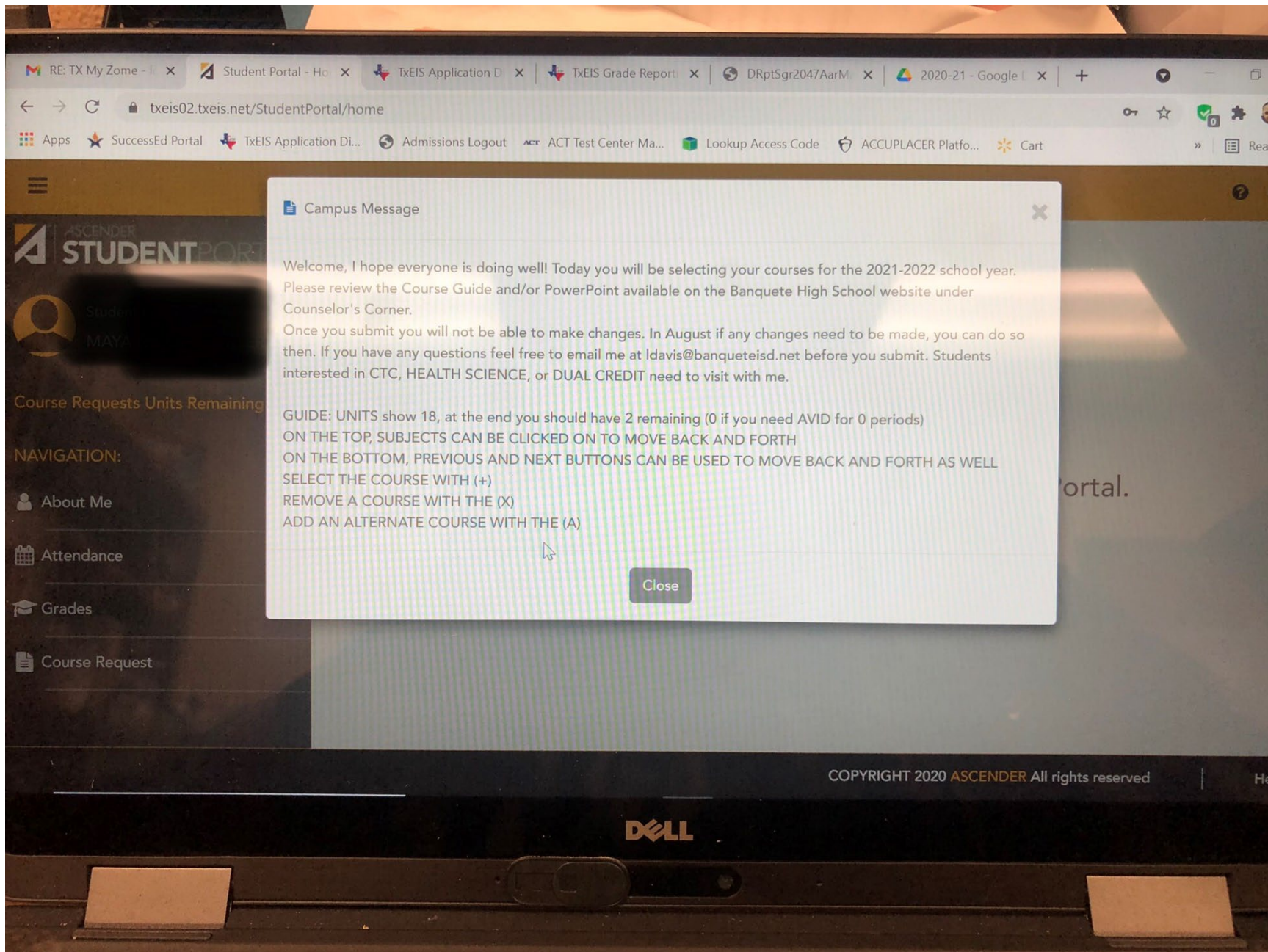
