



FINANCES – TAX RATES

BANQUETE ISD TAX RATE COMPONENTS

M&O Tax Rate: \$0.78560

I&S Tax Rate: \$0.40846

Total Tax Rate: \$1.19406

I&S may not exceed \$0.50

M&O "Maintenance & Operations" Tax Rate

 Funds used to operate the school district such as salaries, utilities, equipment, supplies

I&S "Interest & Sinking" Tax Rate

- May only be used for the repayment of voter approved bonds by election
- Examples: construction, land, buses, technology, HVAC, roofing

FINANCES – TAXPAYER IMPACT

IMPACT TO PROPERTY OWNER

"Assuming average home is \$130,000 and using the \$100,000 Statewide Homeowner Exemption for school taxes"

| I&S INCREASE | YEARLY IMPACT | MONTHLY IMPACT |
|--------------|---------------|----------------|
| \$ 0.01 | \$ 3.00 | \$0.25 |
| \$ 0.02 | \$ 6.00 | \$0.50 |
| \$ 0.05 | \$15.00 | \$1.25 |
| \$0.09 | \$27.30 | \$2.28 |



There is NO <u>school tax</u> impact to those over 65 years of age with Homestead Exemption or those with Disabled status who have applied for and received such exemption from the appraisal district.
