# Dual Credit Information



All BHS students interested in dual enrollment may enroll in the amount of classes limited by CBC and/or DMC.

**Students/Parents are responsible for payment of tuition, fees and books.**

**Scholarships and Grants may be available on a first come first serve basis. Student must complete required forms to be considered.**

Reimbursement of tuition and fees is allowed for Core Area classes (English, Math, Science, and Social Studies) once the course is complete based on the grade that is earned. {A=100%, B=75%, C=50% reimbursement}

Reimbursement of books is allowed for Core Area classes.

**For reimbursements to be processed a copy of the bill/receipt and grades (for tuition) must be submitted to Ms. Davis**




